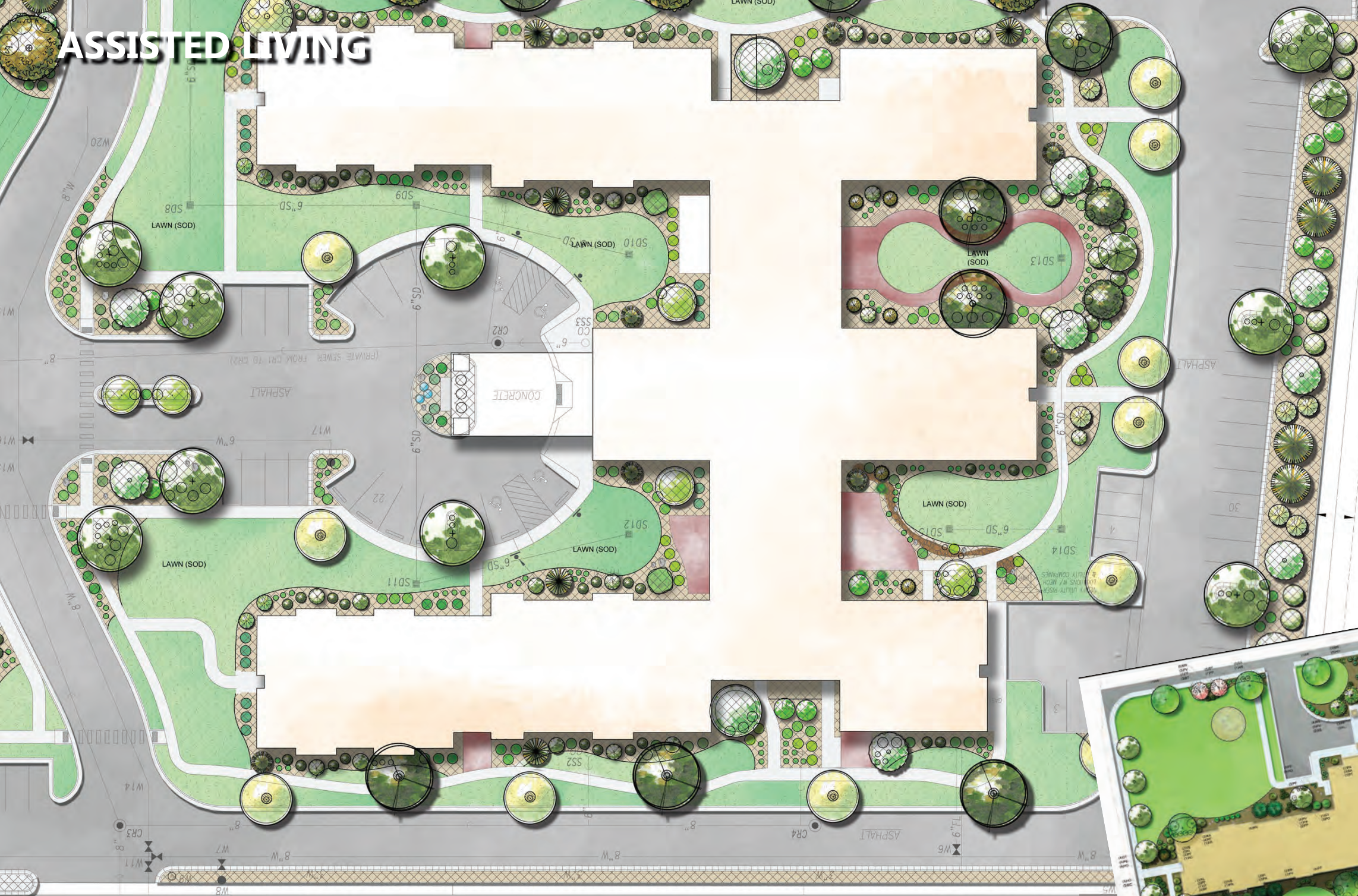

The pathways and landscape were utilized to create a peaceful walk for people using the area and allowing proper connects for flow in and out of the building. Lots of trees were incorporated so that privacy could be achieved, especially in the two patio areas in the back. These areas were spots for serene sitting areas, open lawn, planter pots, and a dry streambed for visual interest. Incorporating the landscape appropriately with the building layout created places where patrons can be well and interact with nature on a daily basis.
